TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All sites booked must be paid for by 5.00pm November 1st or space will be given to next in line. All displays must be completed by 9am Tuesday 18th November and remain until 4.00pm Wednesday 19th November. Displays must be removed within 24 hours of this date and time. Site must be left clean. Sites to be manned from 9am to 4pm each day. All rentals must be paid in full by November 1st. If cancelled a 30% service fee will be retained. Refund of balance will occur if space is re-booked. All space holders must operate and display their goods within the confines of the area for which they have paid. Space holders must not obstruct the use of any firefighting equipment or electrical switchboards and must maintain free access to such equipment at all times. The Organisers accepts no liability for damages to exhibits by loss, damage, theft, fire water, storms, strikes, riots or any other cause whatsoever. Each stand must carry at least one fire extinguisher of approved types and suitable for use on the display. Each exhibitor will receive a name badge, which will be your official identification and must be worn at all times. All exhibitors are responsible for removal of rubbish from their sites. All exhibitors are required to uphold the Orange Function Centre OH&S policy. Exhibitors shall cover their public risk liability for a minimum of \$10 million. Evidence of such insurance shall be provided to Carbon Farmers of Australia at the time of application for space. Indemnity – Neither the Carbon Farmers of Australia nor Central West Catchment Management Authority will be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by an exhibitor, and it shall be a condition of exhibition that each exhibitor shall hold the organizers harmless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such accidents.
